In Ezekiel 36:26–27 God promised that certain things would happen when a person is born again and saved: "A new heart also will I give you (a new inner control center that is bent toward God and His ways), and a new spirit will I put within you (a new nature or new disposition and orientation of life, the very life and nature of God which produces new drives, desires, determination to live for God): and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh (a hard, unresponsive, insensitive, calloused heart that is against God and His ways), and I will give you an heart of flesh (a soft, pliable, sensitive, heart that is responsive to God's commands and ways). And I will put my spirit within you (the Holy Spirit), and cause you to walk in my statutes, and ye shall keep my judgments, and do them (the Holy Spirit will give us the power to accomplish God's will and live a new way of life that consists of good works and obedience to God).

Philippians 2:13 is the New Testament equivalent:

"For it is God which worketh in you both to will (providing us with new incentive, drive, determination, and willpower to follow His righteous path and will for our lives) and to do of his good pleasure" (to provide us with the power to accomplish His holy purposes and ways for our lives).
