- We must factor in the importance of spiritual alertness (Mark 13:33, 1 Cor. 10:12; Heb. 3:12; 1 Peter 5:8; Deut. 4:23).
- We must fortify our lives with the Lord's power (Eph. 1:19-23; 6:10; 2 Pet. 1:3; Phil. 2:13; 3:10; 1 John 4:4).
- We must fasten our mind on truth and godly virtues (Eph. 6:17; Rom. 12:2; Phil. 4:8).
- We must fearlessly claim our victory and riches in Christ (Eph. 1:3; Josh. 1:3; 2 Chron. 20:15; Rev. 12:11).
- We must experience the fullness of God (Eph. 3:19; 4:13).
- We must keep the flame of passion burning in our hearts and do what is right (Eph. 6:14-15; 1 Cor. 15:58).
- We must respond favorably to God's revelation (Ezra 7:10; Ps. 119:2, 10-15).

- We must flourish in our worship of God (Ps. 5:3; 95:6; 96:9; 1 Chron. 16:29).
- We must not falsify our true condition before God (Rev. 3:17; 2 Pet. 1:9; Rom. 7:24; Gal. 6:7).
- We must not be fooled by lust (James 1:14-15; Gen. 3:6; Josh. 7:21).
- We must not allow sin to fester in our lives (Prov. 28:13; Eph. 4:31-32; 4:26; Heb. 12:15).
- We must not live on the outward fringe or border of sin (Gen. 13:12; Prov. 6:27-28).
- We must fix our hearts on steering clear from all sin (Prov. 4:14-15; Romans 13:14).
- We must finally or ultimately choose to do what is right (Deut. 30:19; Josh. 24:15; 2 Cor. 7:1).
- We must not believe foul spirits (1 John 4:1; 1 Tim. 4:1).
- We must believe the fact of God's enduring promise (Deut. 31:6; Josh. 1:5; 1 Chron. 28:20; Heb. 13:5).
- We must remain fundamental in doctrine (Titus 1:9; 2:1; 1 Tim. 6:3).
- We must not fail to judge properly and be discerning (John 7:24; Eph. 5:11; 1 Thess. 5:21; Heb. 5:14).
- We must not falsely conclude that we are better than others and elevate ourselves above others (Matt. 7:1-5; 2 Cor. 10:12; Gal. 6:1).
- We must favor the good over the evil (Amos 5:15; Ps. 97:10; 119:128; Prov. 8:13; Numb. 13:33).
- We must forcefully demolish wrong patterns of thinking (2 Cor. 10:5).
- We must not favor the past life over our present victory (Numb. 11:5; Phil. 3:13).
- We must remember that God freely gives us all we need to live godly and victoriously (Rom. 8:32; 1 Cor. 2:12).
- We should not make friends with the world (James 4:4).
- We must feed the new nature and not FAN the flame of the old nature (2 Peter 1:4; Phil. 2:13; Rom. 7:22-24; Ps. 101:3).
- We must faithfully practice Bible separation (2 Cor. 6:14-18; Rom. 12:2; Eph. 5:11).
- We must walk by faith in God's provision and promises (Eph. 6:16; 1 John 5:4; Heb. 11).
- We must reject feelings that do not align with truth (Ps. 15:2; 86:11; 119:30, 151; Prov. 3:3; John 8:32; 17:17; 1 Cor. 5:8; 3 John 3).

- We must forbid the devil to gain ground in our lives (Eph. 4:27).
- We must fiercely maintain our ground *defensively* by using God's armor (Eph. 6:10-12).
- We must not fluctuate spending time with and being influenced by God's people (Heb. 10:25; Prov. 11:14; Gal. 6:1; James 5:19-20).
- We must function in life according to the principle of grace – not law (Titus 2:11-12; Rom. 6:1-14; John 1:16).
- We must fully submit to God and resist the devil (James 4:7; Rom. 12:1).
- We must be filled with the Spirit's power (Eph. 5:18; Gal. 5:25; 1 Thess. 5:19).
- We must focus on our sanctifying relationship with Christ (Rom. 6:1-14; Gal. 2:20; Phil. 3:10; Heb. 12:2).
- We must fulfill our obligation to pray (Matt. 26:41; Eph. 6:18).
- We must not become fatigued in living for Christ (Gal. 6:9; 1 Thess. 3:13).
- We must put form (structure and discipline) around our life (1 Cor. 9:24-27).
- We must fear God and keep His commandments (Phil. 2:12; 2 Cor. 7:1; Deut. 6:2; 8:6; 17:19; Eccl. 12:13).

- We must remember the ferocious character of the Devil (1 Pet. 5:8).
- We must not be fooled with the deception of Satan (2 Cor. 11:3, 14-15; Gen. 3:1)
- We must fellowship with God on a daily basis (1 John 1:7).
- We must not forget what God has done for us (Deut. 6:12; 8:11; 15:15; 16:12; Deut. 24:22).
- We must face temptation with God's promise (1 Cor. 10:13; Job 23:10; Rom. 8:28).
