John 3:16 According to Hyper Arminianism

For God (a God who looked ahead through the corridors of time and determined to choose all people to salvation if each person continues in their faith and meets God's requirements and conditions for salvation through good works and perseverance) so loved the world (every person who has ever lived in the world – those people who have voluntarily sinned without necessarily being condemned for Adam's own sin or guilt) that he gave his only begotten Son (so everyone could be saved through Jesus, if they cooperate with the CONDITIONS for salvation, endure in good works up to the end of their lives, which maintains their salvation and standing before God through an undetermined amount or percentage of meritorious good deeds) that whosoever believeth in him (a belief in Jesus which includes the kind of faith that is willing to follow Christ through baptism, good works, a faith that is willing to pay the price of discipleship, by submitting one's entire life to God and walking the narrow road which leads to eternal life) should not perish (unless they forfeit their salvation by losing their faith or failing to live out a life that is honorable before God) but have everlasting life (unless they fall from grace which is also CONDITIONED upon a person's obedience, confession of sins, and perseverance in good works a promised everlasting life that is based upon good works, which must be maintained up to the very end of one's life, so that a person can possess hope that they will be accepted by God and go to Heaven in the end, if they have lived a good enough life and confessed all of their known sins before closing their eyes in death). **Pastor Kelly Sensenig**
