The Davidic Covenant in Capsule Form

2 Samuel 7:16

"And thine house and thy kingdom shall be established for ever before thee: thy throne shall be established for ever."

There are three major promises that make up the Davidic Covenant:

1. An eternal seed ("thine house ... for ever" - 2 Samuel 7:16) - a seed forever - (a physical posterity of people that will be able to produce the royal king)

There is a **present** promise (Israel will always exist as a people) and a **prophetic** promise (Israel as God's people will rule with Him eternally or forever in a kingdom).

2. <u>An eternal kingdom</u> ("thy kingdom ... for ever" - 2 Samuel 7:16) – **a kingdom forever**

There is a **present** promise (the kingdom will always have the potential to be restored) and a **prophetic** promise (it will last forever when it is restored).

3. <u>An eternal throne</u> ("thy throne ... forever" - 2 Samuel 7:16) – **a king forever** **(royal descendent to reign)**

There is a **present** promise (Israel will always have a royal descendent - 2 Chron. 6:16) and a **prophetic** promise (a royal descendent will rule eternally or forever in a kingdom).

Israel will then experience the literal fulfillment of her Davidic covenant promises. The covenant can be summed up in this way. An eternal seed will rule in an eternal kingdom over which an eternal Davidic King will rule on an eternal throne.
